


Do you own, rent or share your home?




How satisfied are you with the reliability of electricity on the reservation today?


Does your household have issues with any of these? (Select all that apply)

Of these benefits that could be brought to the community through energy development, which are most important to you? (Select up to three)




Would you be interested in job or training opportunities related to energy development?




What types of job or training opportunities would interest you most? (Select all that apply)



If possible, what energy sources do you think the Tribe should prioritize for development? (Select all that apply)








Do you own or are you interested in owning an electric vehicle (EV)?
